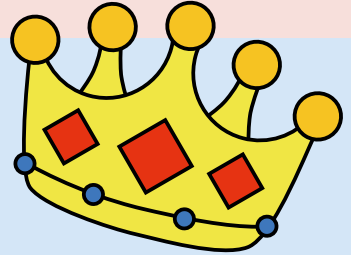
## BBQ & Live Music, The Great Shefford Pub

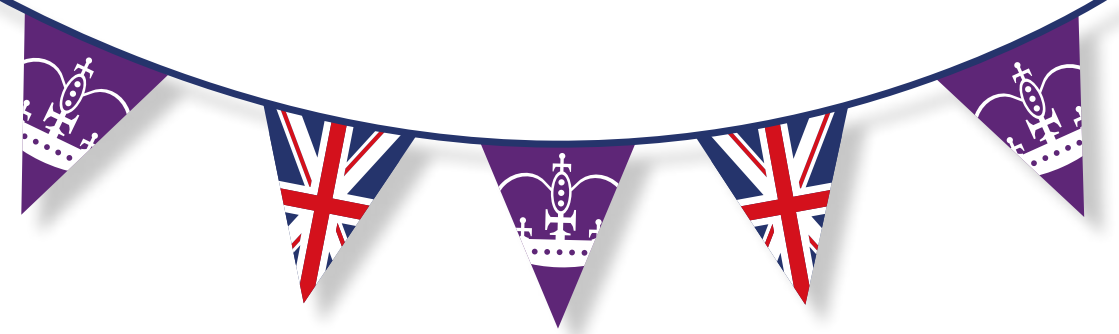
The Big Lunch, which is run by the Eden Project, a simple idea to encourage people to meet up with their neighbours and community to get to know one another better.
